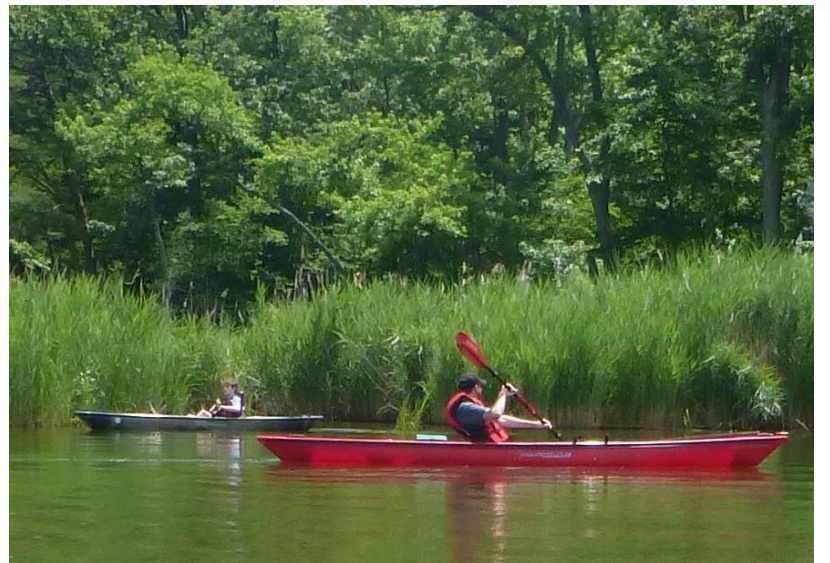
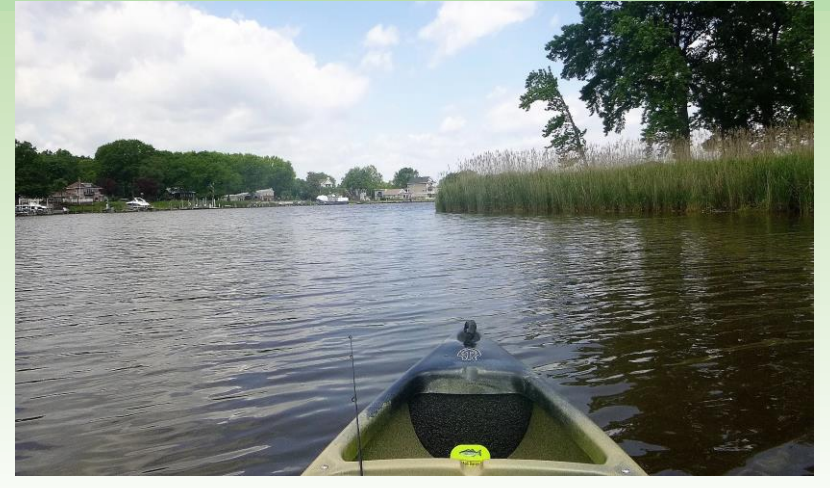


Attributes

- Shallow
- Tidal (Ft. McHenry)
- Largely protected from wind
- Multiple environments
 - High density to natural
- Scenic
- Good species variety
 - Channel cats
 - Yellow perch
 - White perch
 - Pickerel
 - Stripers
