### **Recommended Gear:**

**Fly rods** – 4 to 6 weight with floating lines or sink tips.

**Flies** – Clousers and Crystal Buggers in all yellow, white and yellow, or blue and white. Dark colored wooly buggers in olive and black. Sizes 4 to 6.

**Conventional tackle** -- Light Spinning Rods with Beetle Spins, Mepps Spinners, 1/8 oz. Jigs with 2 to 3-inch Mr. Twisters. If water is turbid, “noisy” lures work better than flies.

**Kayaks or Canoes** – Although there is ample shore line fishing at the park at the beach and along the riprap, best water coverage is obtained via a car-top boat. Boat trailers are not allowed in the park.

### **Notes:**

Although they may be present, it is illegal to target stripers on 31 August. If you catch one on that date, return it to the water immediately. Legal striper fishing will resume on 1 September.

Pickrel have returned and been common catches in the Severn this year.

There have a few catches of small redbfish caught in the Severn this year.

### **Safety:**

Please adhere to COVID 19 social distancing guidelines at the park. Also, we will not have our customary lunch gathering after fishing.

Boaters -- Please wear your PFD and be cautious on the water.
