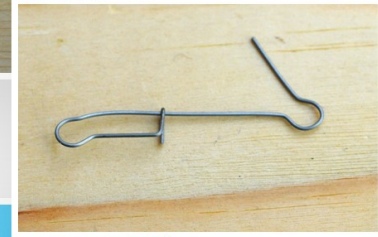


OPTION:

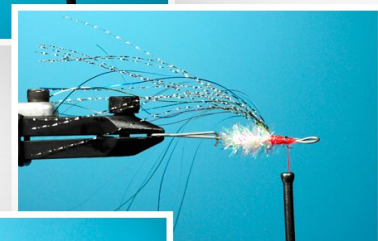
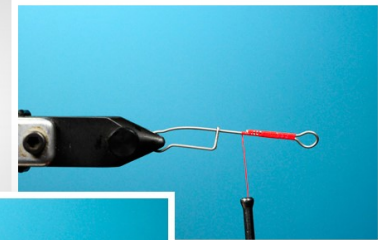
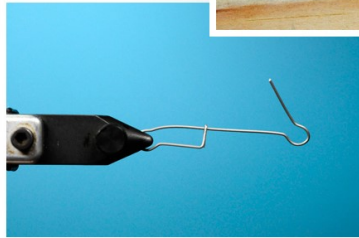
An articulated form for jigs, flukes or flies to add more animation and length.

1. Cut a #11 wire length to 4 1/4"
2. Make a basic loop on one end using the large pin.
3. Measure up the tool 2 1/8" and bend the wire end to form a beetle spin loop. **Both loops should be in the same plane.**



TYING INSTRUCTIONS

1. Place the form in the vise and attach the thread and bind down the line loop.
2. Cut a 2" piece of crystal chenille and make 5 wraps toward the line loop and tie off.
3. Cut some tinsel 3" long and tie down on top of the shank. **Make sure this is on the same plane as the loops.**
4. Take a pair of grizzly saddles and tie one on each side of the shank.
5. Cut a bundle of streamer hair about 3" long, align and push the butts over the line eye and tie down.
6. Pull the hair back and tie down, whip finish and apply head cement to the wraps. A piece of tubing or an empty pen helps to push the material back.
