Mark Bange will teach club members how to use Gary Krebs jigs to shape and tie simple, yet very effective fly fishing popper patterns using foam cylinders. This club sponsored event, free to FSFF members, is part of a continuing series of club sponsored Saturday sessions focused on hands-on demonstrations of all aspects of fly fishing.

Mark will demonstrate a series of techniques so you can stop buying expensive popper patterns and start tying them yourself. During his hands-on demonstrations, Mark will cover the following:

- **Choosing the right type of foam material as a starting point**
- **Using foam cutting jigs of various sizes to cut out the foam bodies**
- **Selecting the right hooks for the size and type of poppers you want to tie**
- **Different techniques for placing the foam body on the hook**
- **Adding rubber legs to your foam body popper**
- **Making choices about what types of materials to tie in the tail of your foam body popper and how to finish off your popper**
