Recommended Gear:

Fly rods – 4 to 6 weight with floating lines or sink tips.

Flies – Clousers and Crystal Buggers in all yellow, white and yellow, or blue and white. Dark colored wooly buggers in olive and black. Sizes 4 to 6.

Conventional tackle -- Light Spinning Rods with Beetle Spins, Mepps Spinners, 1/8 oz. Jigs with 2 to 3-inch Mr. Twisters. If water is turbid, "noisy" lures work better than flies.

Kayaks or Canoes – Although there is ample shore line fishing at the park at the beach and along the riprap, best water coverage is obtained via a car-top boat. Boat trailers are not allowed in the park.

Lunch: Because of the upswing in Covid, we will not go to a restaurant for lunch, but we will gather for a shore lunch on the beach near the launch point at Jonas Green Park to allow ample opportunity to lie about your catch! Bring along your own picnic lunch and a chair!

Safety: Safety is a paramount concern on all FSFF sponsored outings. On all FSFF sponsored outings, please be safe out there as it is your responsibility to stay within your capabilities and practice water safety at all time. Check with the above listed outing coordinator for more information on the fishing conditions if you have any concerns or questions. If boating, always wear your PFD and if water temperatures are below 60 degrees F, have a plan to protect yourself from cold water immersion hazards should you fall in. Most importantly, enjoy the fellowship of your fellow members through fly fishing and tight lines!
