If they catch a fish of a lifetime, they will only have a low-quality picture that is only good on the web or laptop. It cannot be blown up to frame.

Joe's presentation will include how to set up your camera, positioning the subject for more interest and how cropping a shot will make a big difference and more. Bring your cameras and we can hopefully set them to take that “Kodak Moment” and be able to blow it up to be framed.
