Clouser Deep Minnow



Hook: Mustad S71SNP 1/0 or 2/0, or Mustad 34007 1/0 or 2/0

Eyes: Hareline Pseudo Eyes, medium or large, or MFC Sparkle Eyes, large

Thread: Danville 3/0, 140 or 210 denier, your choice of color

Flash: Hareline Pearl Krystal Flash Wings: Bucktail, your choice of colors

For Crappie and White Perch



Hook: Mustad 34007, size 4

Eyes: Hareline Pseudo Eyes, small or Hareline black dumb bell eyes, small

Thread: Danville 3/0 or 140 denier, your choice of color

Flash: Hareline Pearl Krystal Flash Wings: Calf tail, your choice of colors

Clouser Tying Instructions

Step 1:	Place hook in the vise
Step 2:	Tie a thread bump at the black mark on the hook shank
Step 3:	Tie in the dumbbell eyes at the back of the thread bump
Step 4:	Wrap the thread forward to the eye of the hook and then back to a point that is midway between the dumbbell eyes and the hook eye
Step 5:	Measure and cut a small bundle of white bucktail
Step 6:	Tie in the white bucktail by placing the cut end at the eye of the hook, take three loose collecting wraps, and then cinch tight, wrapping toward the hook eye.
Step 7:	Bring the thread to behind the dumbbell eyes and finish tying in the white bucktail. Bring the thread back to the eye of the hook
Step 8:	Turn the hook over
Step 9:	Tie in three or four strands of Krystal flash on each side of the hook ending slightly longer than the white bucktail
Step 10:	Bring the thread to the midpoint between the hook eye and the dumbbell eyes
Step 11:	Measure and cut a small bundle of bucktail wing, your choice of color
Step 12:	Tie in the bucktail the same as in Step 6
Step 13:	Make a tapered head and finish the fly with head cement, nail polish, or UV resin
