Adam Bange will teach club members how tie deerhair poppers using the stacking hair technique. This club sponsored event, free to FSFF members and all visitors, is part of a continuing series of club sponsored Saturday sessions focused on hands-on demonstrations of all aspects of fly fishing.

Many of us use cork or rigid foam poppers when we fish for bass or panfish which work effectively in many situations. But there are definitely times which call for casting a deerhair popper which usually sits deeper in the water at the surface and provides for softer “pop” when you strip you fly line. And those of us who tie deerhair poppers and are used to “spinning” deerhair, this will definitely a new technique for tying deerhair poppers.

Adam will teach how to stack deerhair as an alternative approach to tying deerhair poppers. The major difference is stacking deerhair enables the fly tyer to achieve some truly incredible coloring of the resultant deerhair popper.
